No. 2) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1960

The Queen's most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue of the powers conferred upon Her by article 117 of the Constitution of the West Indies annexed to the West Indies (Federation) Order in Council, 1957(a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Constitution of the West Indies (Amendment No. 2) Order in Council, 1960, and shall be construed as one with the Constitution of the West Indies, as amended by the Constitution of the West Indies (Amendment) Order in Council, 1959, and the Constitution of the West Indies (Amendment) Order in Council, 1960, and the Constitution of the West Indies, as so amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the Constitution".

(2) This Order shall be published in the Gazette and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Governor-General by proclamation published in the Gazette.

5.—(1) The Governor-General may, by Order published in the Gazette, at any time within twelve months after the commencement of this Order, provide that any law of the Federal Legislature in force immediately before the commencement of this Order shall be read and construed with such adaptations and modifications as may appear to the Governor-General to be necessary or expedient for bringing the provisions of that law into conformity with the provisions of this Order or otherwise for giving effect or enabling effect to be given to those provisions; and any such law shall have effect accordingly from such date as may be specified in the Order, not being a date earlier than the commencement of this Order.

(2) An Order made under this section may be revoked or amended by a further Order so made or, in relation to any law affected thereby, by the authority having power to repeal, revoke or amend that law.
