ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (PRE-CARNIVAL) ORDER, 1993

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Pre-Carnival) Order, 1993.
- 2. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists Parking of attending any Pre-Carnival functions at the Grand Stand may park vehicles on their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah during the period Savannah commencing three hours before the start of the function and ending three hours after the close of the function.

Pre-Carnival Functions at the Grand Stand, Queen's Park Savannah

3. Between the hours of-

Parking prohibited

- 11.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Saturday, 13th February, 1993;
- 7.30 a.m. to 7.30 p.m. on Sunday, 14th February, 1993;
- 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Monday, 15th February, 1993;
- 6.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 16th February, 1993 and 2.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 17th February, 1993;
- 6.00 p.m. on Friday, 19th February, 1993 and 2.00 a.m. on Saturday, 20th February, 1993;
- 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Saturday, 20th February, 1993-
 - (a) parking is prohibited on the following roads:
 - (i) Queen's Park West except for taxis plying for hire at the Prince's Building Taxi Stand between Queen's Park East and Stanmore Avenue;
 - (ii) Chancery Lane;
 - (iii) Albion Street, between Stanmore Avenue and Chancery Lane;

- (iv) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;
- (v) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (vi) Keate Street;
- (vii) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (b) parking is permitted on the following roads:
 - (i) Stanmore Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side;
 - (ii) Victoria Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side except for Public Transport Service Corporation buses which may park on the eastern side between Albion Street and Queen's Park West, facing South;
 - (iii) Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side;
 - (iv) Cummins Lane—on the southern side:
 - (v) Tranquillity Street—on the southern side;
 - (vi) Dere Street-on the western side.

Road closed

4. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on Western Main Road, between Long Circular Road and George Cabral Street and on all streets intersecting with Western Main Road during the hours of 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m.

Alternative route

- 5. Subject to clause 4, vehicular traffic on the following roads shall proceed as follows:
 - (a) vehicles travelling West along Western Main Road shall turn North onto Long Circular Road, West into Delhi Street, then onto Kathleen Street and South onto George Cabral Street, re-entering Western Main Road;
 - (b) vehicles travelling East along Western Main Road, shall turn North onto George Cabral Street, East onto Kathleen Street, then onto Delhi Street and South onto Long Circular Road, re-entering Western Main Road.

Parking prohibited

- 6. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:
 - (a) Long Circular Road, between Delhi Street and Western Main Road;

- (b) George Cabral Street, between Kathleen Street and Western Main Road;
- (c) Western Main Road, between Coronation Street and Roxy Roundabout.

- 7. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited between the hours Roads of 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the following roads:

 - (0) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
 - (p) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;

 - (r) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane.

Parking prohibited

- 8. Parking is prohibited from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on the following roads:
 - (a) Chancery Lane;
 - (b) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue.

One-way

- 9. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m.:
 - (a) on Keate Street, between Pembroke Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction;
 - (b) on Chancery Lane-in a northerly direction;
 - (c) on Gordon Street, between Pembroke Street and St. Vincent Street—in a westerly direction;
 - (d) on Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street—in an easterly direction;
 - (e) on Albion Street—in a westerly direction;
 - (f) on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay—in a southerly direction.

Two-way

- 10. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, vehicular traffic may, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m., proceed in both directions—
 - (a) along the Queen's Park Savannah, between Marli Street and Queen's Park East, by way of Circular Road;
 - (b) on Charlotte Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park East.

Maxi-taxis

11. Maxi-taxis which normally ply for hire from Charlotte Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South shall ply for hire from the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Piccadilly Street.

Taxi stands

- 12. Taxis that normally ply—
 - (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street shall ply for hire from the southern side of Queen Street, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street;
 - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street shall ply for hire from the western side of Henry Street between Queen Street, and Prince Street;
 - (c) from Cipriani Circle shall ply for hire from the northern side of South Quay, between St. Vincent Street and Broadway.

CARNIVAL FUNCTIONS AT INDEPENDENCE SQUARE ON SUNDAY, 21st February, 1993

- 13. Parking is prohibited between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and Parking 7.00 p.m. on the following roads:
 - (a) Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and George Street;
 - (b) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South;
 - (c) Cipriani Circle;
 - (d) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North.
- 14. Vehicular traffic is prohibited between the hours of 12.00 noon Roads and 7.00 p.m. on the following roads:
 - (a) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North;
 - (b) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square North and Independence Square South;
 - (c) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South;
 - (d) Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and George Street.

DIMANCHE GRAS—NATIONAL STADIUM SUNDAY, 21st February, 1993

- 15. Parking is prohibited between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Parking Sunday, 21st February, 1993 and 2.00 a.m. on Monday, 22nd February, prohibited 1993 on the following roads:
 - (a) Fitzblackman Drive;
 - (b) Wrightson Road Extension;
 - (c) Hamilton Holder Street;
 - (d) Dennis Mahabir Street;
 - (e) De Verteuil Street;
 - (f) Wrightson Road, between Colville Street and Hamilton Holder Street;
 - (g) Maraval Parkway, except for vehicles conveying costumes and floats which will be allowed to park on the eastern shoulder, from a point twenty-five metres South of Fitzblackman Drive to a point twenty-five metres North of Audrey Jeffers Highway.

One-way

- 16. Motorists shall proceed as follows:
 - (a) in an easterly direction on Wrightson Road Extension, between Fitzblackman Drive and Ana Street;
 - (b) on Fitzblackman Drive, between Maraval Parkway and Wrightson Road Extension—
 - (i) before and during the show, in a southerly direction;
 - (ii) after the show, in a northerly direction.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

Chap. 48:50

17. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
