1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1983.

2. The Customs (Fees) Regulations, 1957, are hereby amended—

(a) by revoking regulation 4 thereof and replacing it as follows—

“ 4. (1) The overtime fees for duties performed by officers for any period of time in excess of the hours set out in these Regulations, are payable to the Comptroller at the following rates—

(a) on ordinary week-days—

- (b) for the entering or clearing of a vessel other than a coasting vessel \$86.96 for each entrance or clearance; and where two or more applications are made at the same time by the same person the rate shall be \$43.48 for each additional entrance or clearance;
- (c) for the entering or clearing of a coasting vessel \$16.23 for each entrance or clearance;
- (d) for the granting of an application to load ships' stores of any kind excluding bunkers \$86.96;
- (e) for the granting of a supplementary application extending the duration of a service or requiring the employment of additional officers \$86.96;
- (f) for the boarding of ships other than coasting vessel or aircraft \$97.00;
- (g) for the issuing of a Loading Licence or a Permit to discharge coastwise \$97.00; and
- (h) for the searching of a content \$97.00: Provided that where two or more applications are made at the same time by the same person the rate shall be \$48.50 for each additional search of a Content.

(2) On Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays, and on other days between 5.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m. overtime fees for one hour in excess of the actual time occupied in performing the service required (subject to a minimum of two hours in all) shall be paid in respect of each officer employed so as to cover the time spent in travelling to and from the place of employment.

(3) Where arrangements have been made for summoning an officer and no demand is ultimately made for his service a fee equivalent to two hours overtime shall be paid to the Comptroller.”;

(b) in regulation 8—

- (i) by substituting for the figures “10.50” occurring therein, the figures “19.97”; and
- (ii) by substituting for the figures “5.53” occurring therein, the figures “12.00”; and

(c) in regulation 9—

- (i) by substituting for the figures “54.00” occurring therein, the figures “103.00”;

- (ii) by substituting for the figures "2093.00" occurring therein, the figures "3919.00"; and
- (iii) by substituting for the figures "1821.00" wherever they occur therein, the figures "3461.00".
