AN ACT to amend the Firearms Act, Chap. 16:01

[Assented to 4th December, 1992]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Firearms (Amend- Short title
ment) Act, 1992.

Chap. 16:01
amended

2. Section 6(2) of the Firearms Act is repealed and replaced as follows:

“ (2) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a person may not have in his possession any prohibited weapon unless he is, and is acting in the capacity of—

- (a) a police officer;
- (b) a member of the Defence Force;
- (c) a customs officer while patrolling the territorial sea; or
- (d) a prison officer.”.
