## **Act No. 8 of 2026**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Law Revision Act, Chap. 3:03

*[Assented to 15th May, 2026]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the Law Revision Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 2026.
- 2.** This Act shall come into operation on such date as Commencement  
is fixed by the President by Proclamation.
- 3.** In this Act, "the Act" means the Law Revision Act. Interpretation

Section 2 amended

**4.** Section 2 of the Act is amended by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical sequence, the following definitions:

“designated website” means the website specified in an Order under section 5A(1);

“electronic version of the Laws” means a written law that is published in accordance with section 5A(2);

“PDF” means Portable Document Format;”.

Sections 5A, 5B, and 5C inserted

**5.** The Act is amended by inserting after section 5, the following sections:

“Publication of electronic versions of the Laws

5A. (1) The Minister may, by Order, designate a website as the sole official website for the publication of electronic versions of the Laws.

(2) An electronic version of the Laws that is published on the designated website shall be in PDF or such other format as the Minister may, by Order, approve.

(3) An electronic copy or printout of an electronic version of the Laws shall, unless the contrary is proven, be deemed to be official and authoritative if—

(a) it is accessed or downloaded from the designated website;

(b) it is in PDF or such other approved format; and

(c) it meets the prescribed requirements with respect to—

(i) the manner in which the electronic copy or printout is created, recorded,

transmitted, stored,  
authenticated,  
received, displayed  
or perceived; and

- (ii) any statement, mark  
or certification  
associated with the  
creation, recording,  
transmission, storage,  
authentication, recep-  
tion, display or  
perception of the  
electronic copy or  
printout.

(4) The Minister may make  
regulations prescribing any of the matters  
in subsection (3)(c).

Discrepancies  
between  
printouts and  
electronic  
versions

5B. On or after the coming into opera-  
tion of the Law Revision (Amendment)  
Act, 2026, where there is any inconsistency  
between the Laws published under section 5  
and an electronic version of the Laws  
published under section 5A, the electronic  
version of the Laws shall prevail over the  
Laws published under section 5 to the  
extent of the inconsistency.

Correction of  
electronic  
version of the  
Laws

5C. Where a correction is made to any  
electronic version of the Laws which is  
already published on the designated  
website, the Commission shall publish on  
the designated website a notice of the  
correction.”.

**6.** The Act is amended in section 6, by inserting after Section 6 amended  
subsection (3), the following subsection:

“(4) This section shall not apply to an  
electronic version of the Laws.”.


Section 15 amended

7. Section 15 of the Act is amended, by inserting after the word “Laws”, the words “, including the electronic version of the Laws published under section 5A,”.

Section 16 amended

8. Section 16 of the Act is amended in the *chapeau*, by inserting after the word “9” the words “or the preparation of an electronic version of the Laws”.


