ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(CORPUS CHRISTI) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Corpus Christi) Order, 2026.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. Duration on Thursday 4th June, 2026.

3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on the following roads: ^{Parking prohibited}

- (a) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (b) Henry Street, between Independence Square South and Park Street;
- (c) George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square North;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Nelson Street;
- (e) Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Duncan Street; and
- (f) Nelson Street, between Duke Street and South Quay.

4. A driver shall not drive his motor vehicle between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. on the following roads: ^{Vehicular traffic prohibited}

- (a) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Nelson Street;
- (b) Independence Square South, between Nelson Street and Henry Street;
- (c) Henry Street, between Independence Square South and Park Street;
- (d) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Piccadilly Street;

- (e) Piccadilly Street, between Park Street and Duke Street;
- (f) Duke Street, between Piccadilly Street and Nelson Street;
- (g) Nelson Street, between Duke Street and Independence Square South; and
- (h) George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square North.

Taxi stand 5. The taxi stand on George Street shall operate from the southern side of South Quay facing west between Duncan Street and George Street.

Removal of
vehicles 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a member of the Police Service may, in accordance with section 108 of the Act, remove or cause to be removed a vehicle that is parked in contravention of this Order, or left on any road in such a manner that it is likely to cause an obstruction to persons lawfully using the road.
