THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing her from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention, make an order that she be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to AKEEMA FERGUSON also known as “KIMA” of Light Pole No. 12, Passiflora, Longdenville, Chaguanas and also of Opal Crescent, Edinburgh 500, that it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention with a view to preventing her from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said AKEEMA FERGUSON also known as “KIMA” of Light Pole No. 12, Passiflora, Longdenville, Chaguanas and

also of Opal Crescent, Edinburgh 500, shall be detained at the Women's Prison, Golden Grove, Arouca, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said AKEEMA FERGUSON also known as "KIMA" of Light Pole No. 12, Passiflora, Longdenville, Chaguanas and also of Opal Crescent, Edinburgh 500, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, AKEEMA FERGUSON also known as "KIMA" has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group ('OCG') within the legal definition in the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, which is unnamed and operates in the Central Trinidad area. She provides real time intelligence for the OCG during home invasions. The OCG has access to a cache of firearms and ammunition and is engaged in a spate of armed and violent home invasions in various areas of Central Trinidad. The detainee and others intend to imminently escalate these attacks using firearms in public spaces when confronted by law enforcement.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and to prevent her from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
