THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to, MARK WILLIAMS of Waterhole, Cocorite and also of No. 17 Clifton Road, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said MARK WILLIAMS of Waterhole, Cocorite and also of No. 17 Clifton Road, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at

Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said MARK WILLIAMS of Waterhole, Cocorite and also of No. 17 Clifton Road, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, MARK WILLIAMS has been credibly identified as an active member of an Organised Crime Group (“OCG”) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021 known as the “SIXX gang”. The OCG has confirmed access to firearms and ammunition and is engaged in armed robberies, firearm possession and motor vehicle larceny. The detainee and others have been directed to commit violent armed robberies using firearms to generate revenue for incarcerated gang members and to fund gang activity. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee and others intend to imminently escalate these armed attacks in public spaces using firearms.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
