THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to KESTER BERNARD also known as “BONES” of 5th Street, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain and also of Pensioners Quarters Building, No. 6E Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said KESTER BERNARD also known as “BONES” of 5th Street, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain and also of

Pensioners Quarters Building, No. 6E Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said KESTER BERNARD also known as “BONES” of 5th Street, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain and also of Pensioners Quarters Building, No. 6E Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, KESTER BERNARD also known as “BONES” has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, known as the “7 OCG”. The OCG is engaged in trafficking of narcotics, firearms, armed robberies, home invasions, larceny, violent physical assaults and shootings and has confirmed access to a cache of firearms and ammunition. The detainee, who is an enforcer for the OCG and another were recently found in possession of a firearm and ammunition. The OCG is engaged in a violent gang war with a rival OCG which has resulted in several public shootings and retaliatory attacks. The detainee and others intend to imminently escalate their armed and violent attacks on their gang rivals using firearms in public spaces.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
