THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to BRUCE SINGH also known as “KESTON SINGH” also known as “KESTON THOMAS” of No. 3 Twelfth Street, Phase II, Beetham Gardens, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said BRUCE SINGH also known as “KESTON SINGH” also known as “KESTON THOMAS” of No. 3 Twelfth Street,

Phase II, Beetham Gardens, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said BRUCE SINGH also known as “KESTON SINGH” also known as “KESTON THOMAS” of No. 3 Twelfth Street, Phase II, Beetham Gardens, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, BRUCE SINGH also known as “KESTON SINGH” also known as “KESTON THOMAS” has been credibly identified as an active member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, known to law enforcement as the “Seven Gang”. The OCG has access to firearms and ammunition and is engaged in armed robberies, larceny, drug and firearm trafficking and gang warfare. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee and others monitor members of the public at particular commercial bank locations and follow them after those persons withdraw large sums of cash from the banks and then rob those persons. The detainee is a main actor in these activities and he and others intend to imminently escalate their attacks on members of the public.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
