REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to KENYA ROMEL JABARI GREEN also called “SKELLY” of Apartment No. 2, Building No. 10, Roy Joseph, San Fernando, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said KENYA ROMEL JABARI GREEN also called “SKELLY” of Apartment No. 2, Building No. 10, Roy Joseph,

San Fernando, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said KENYA ROMEL JABARI GREEN also called "SKELLY" of Apartment No. 2, Building No. 10, Roy Joseph, San Fernando, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, KENYA ROMEL JABARI GREEN also called "SKELLY" has been credibly identified as an armed enforcer for criminals and gang leaders who are involved in organised drug trafficking and the distribution of dangerous drugs within the Southern Division. The detainee performs an enforcement role involving the protection of criminal operations through the use or threatened use of firearms and violence. The intelligence further indicates that the detainee has on numerous occasions openly carried and brandished firearms within the Roy Joseph community and has been associated with the planning and commission of robberies within the San Fernando and Mon Repos Police Districts. Confidential intelligence also identifies him as actively participating in an organised criminal network engaged in violent criminal activity. On 24th June, 2026, acting upon confidential intelligence, police officers searched the detainee and recovered from his person a silver and black revolver together with three rounds of ammunition concealed in his waistband. The detainee has a prior criminal matter involving possession of ammunition without a licence, demonstrating a continuing pattern of involvement with illegal firearms and ammunition. The available intelligence and investigative material disclose that, if permitted to remain at liberty, he is likely to continue facilitating organised criminal activity involving firearms, violence, intimidation and drug trafficking, thereby posing a serious and continuing threat to public safety during the present State of Emergency.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and activities and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
