THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to RANDY EMILLE also known as “CHOKO” of Benny Road, Valencia and also of St. Alban’s Road, Valencia and also of No. 103 Eastern Main Road, Arouca, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, hereby order that the said RANDY EMILLE also known as “CHOKO” of Benny Road, Valencia and also of St. Alban’s Road, Valencia and also of

No. 103 Eastern Main Road, Arouca, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said RANDY EMILLE also known as “CHOKO” of Benny Road, Valencia and also of St. Alban’s Road, Valencia and also of No. 103 Eastern Main Road, Arouca, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, RANDY EMILLE also known as “CHOKO” has been credibly identified through confidential intelligence as a member of an Organized Crime Group (‘OCG’) known to law enforcement as the “Arouca Radical Muslim Gang”. The OCG has confirmed access to a cache of firearms and ammunition and is engaged in trafficking of narcotics and firearms, extortion and attacks on rival gangs. The proceeds of the trafficking of narcotics are used to fund the acquisition and dispersal of firearms to members of the OCG and others, for use in criminal activities including the protection of drug blocks. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee is more involved in the OCG’s narcotics trafficking activities and is also involved in child pornography. The detainee and others intend to imminently escalate their activities and attacks on businesspeople, gang rivals and commercial establishments using firearms in public spaces.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and activities and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
