THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 11) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 11) Order, 2026.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

<i>Name</i>	<i>Professional Qualification</i>
Mr. Anthony Nicholas George Peto, K.C.	Of the Honourable Society of the Middle Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in February, 1985 and appointed King's Counsel in 2009.

PART II

Mr. Anthony Nicholas George Peto, K.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to any proceedings in the High Court and in the Court of Appeal on behalf of the Commissioner of Police for matters pertaining to the enforcement of the law on unexplained wealth and proceeds of crime, and to deal with any other proceedings arising out of or in connection with such matters.
