THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to TRESTON PEGUS also known as “GUSSY” of No. 46 Lowkie Trace, Penal and also of Light Pole No. 72, Malabar Road, Arima, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said TRESTON PEGUS also known as “GUSSY” of No. 46 Lowkie Trace, Penal and also of Light Pole No. 72, Malabar Road, Arima, shall be detained at the Remand Prison located at Golden Grove,

Arouca, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said TRESTON PEGUS also known as “GUSSY” of No. 46 Lowkie Trace, Penal and also of Light Pole No. 72, Malabar Road, Arima, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, TRESTON PEGUS also known as “GUSSY” has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) known to law enforcement as the “Pegus OCG”. The OCG has confirmed access to a cache of firearms and ammunition and is engaged in the trafficking of firearms, ammunition, production and distribution of illegal narcotics, armed robberies, shootings and murder. The detainee is the leader of the OCG and directs the group’s activities and finances. Confidential intelligence links the detainee and others to recent homicides in the area which is part of a larger developing conflict between this OCG and another OCG known to law enforcement as the “Barry Maraj OCG”. Further intelligence links the detainee and others to a series of armed robberies in the Siparia district and environs and an imminent escalation of firearm attacks on rival gang members in public places which threaten public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
