THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to SPENCER JAE REVEILLAC of No. 28 St. Andrew's Avenue, Cocoyea Village, San Fernando, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said SPENCER JAE REVEILLAC of No. 28 St. Andrew's Avenue, Cocoyea Village, San Fernando, shall be detained

at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said SPENCER JAE REVEILLAC of No. 28 St. Andrew's Avenue, Cocoyea Village, San Fernando, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, SPENCER JAE REVEILLAC has been credibly identified by confidential intelligence as being actively involved in the illicit trafficking and distribution of illegal firearms and ammunition within the Southern Division. Intelligence further identifies him as a member of an Informal Criminal Group and gang engaged in the illegal firearm trade. On 25th July, 2026, he was apprehended whilst driving motor vehicle registration number PEL 4779, in which officers discovered a concealed Taurus PT92 pistol fitted with a magazine containing twelve (12) rounds of 9mm ammunition. The detainee is not the holder of a Firearm User's Licence or otherwise lawfully authorised to possess the firearm or ammunition. Confidential intelligence further identifies him as a known offender involved in the illegal firearms trade, whose continued liberty presents an immediate and serious threat to public safety. His continued detention is necessary to disrupt the illicit trafficking of firearms, prevent further acts of serious criminality and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety. A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is therefore necessary.
