THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

REVOCATION ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 9 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas on the 27th day of June, 2026, a detention order was made to detain GENEVIEVE HADEED also called GENEVIERVE HADEED of No. 2 Orange Grove Estate, Trincity and also of No. 47 Western Circle, Westmoorings, at the Women's Prison, Golden Grove Road, Arouca, or such other place as the Minister may from time to time direct, pursuant to the Schedule to the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026:

And whereas it is provided at paragraph 9 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may revoke a detention order at any time:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby revoke the detention order dated the 27th day of June, 2026, made in relation to the said GENEVIEVE HADEED also called GENEVIERVE HADEED of No. 2 Orange Grove Estate, Trincity and also of No. 47 Western Circle, Westmoorings.
