MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO SIXTY-FOURTH
ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATIONS)
ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Sixty-Fourth Anniversary of Independence Celebrations) Order, 2026.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. on Monday 31st August, Duration 2026, to 1.00 a.m. on Tuesday 1st September, 2026.

3. (1) On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of Parking 6.00 a.m. and 12.00 p.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on— prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;
- (b) Chancery Lane, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (c) Keate Street;
- (d) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street;
- (e) Park Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (f) New Street;
- (g) Dere Street;
- (h) Albion Street;
- (i) Dundonald Street;
- (j) Circular Road;
- (k) Rapsey Street;
- (l) Gordon Street;

(m) The Western Main Road, between Tragarete Road and Long Circular Road; and

(n) Tragarete Road.

(2) On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on Long Circular Road, between the Western Main Road and Patna Street.

(3) From 12.00 p.m. on Monday 31st August, 2026 to 1.00 a.m. on Tuesday 1st September, 2026, a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on—

(a) Queen's Park West, between Chancery Lane and St. Clair Avenue;

(b) Maraval Road, between St. Clair Avenue and Saddle Road;

(c) Circular Road, between Saddle Road and St. Ann's Road;

(d) The eastern end of Circular Road, between the St. Ann's Road roundabout and Queen's Park East;

(e) Queen's Park East; and

(f) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street.

Vehicular
traffic and

4. (1) On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park or proceed on—

(a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;

(b) Keate Street;

(c) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street;

(d) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue;

(e) New Street;

(f) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
and

(g) Chancery Lane, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West.

(2) On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park or proceed on Park Street, between Henry Street and Edward Street.

(3) On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 12.00 p.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park or proceed on—

(a) Tragarete Road; and

(b) The Western Main Road, between Damian Street and Lucknow Street.

5. On Monday 31st August, 2026, from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m., Two-way traffic vehicular traffic may proceed in both an easterly and a westerly direction on Rapsey Street, between Saddle Road and Wainwright Street.

6. (1) On Monday 31st August, 2026, from 8.00 p.m. to 11.59 p.m., One-way traffic vehicular traffic shall proceed in an easterly direction only on Lady Young Road, between the entrance to the Hilton Hotel and the Lady Young Road lookout.

(2) On Monday 31st August, 2026, from 8.00 p.m. to 11.59 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed in a southerly direction only on Colville Street.

7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
