ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SIXTY-FOURTH ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE
CELEBRATIONS) (SCARBOROUGH) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Sixty-Fourth Anniversary of Independence Celebrations) (Scarborough) Order, 2026.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 30th August, Duration 2026, to 12.00 p.m. on Monday 31st August, 2026.

3. On Monday 31st August, 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not proceed—
Vehicular traffic prohibited

- (a) on Claude Noel Highway, between Bacolet Street and Wilson Road;
- (b) on Friends Field Branch Road, between the Dwight Yorke Parade Grounds and French Fort Road;
- (c) on French Fort Road, between Friends Field Branch Road and Calder Hall Road;
- (d) on Bagatelle Number 2, between Bagatelle Number 1 and Claude Noel Highway;
- (e) north onto Wilson Road, from Carrington Street; and
- (f) north onto Wilson Road, from Milford Road.

4. (1) Between the hours of 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 30th August, 2026, Parking and 12.00 p.m. on Monday 31st August, 2026, a driver of a motor vehicle prohibited shall not park in the following car parks—

- (a) N.I.B. Mall (Formerly FCB Car Park); and
- (b) Market Square Car Park.

(2) On Monday 31st August 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., a driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on—

- (a) Wilson Road;
- (b) Bacolet Street;

- (c) Post Office Street;
- (d) Gardenside Street;
- (e) Carrington Street;
- (f) Sangster Hill Road; and
- (g) Dutch Fort Street.

5. On Monday 31st August 2026, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., a driver of a motor vehicle—

- (a) entering Scarborough from—
 - (i) east and heading in a westerly direction, shall turn onto Bacolet Street and proceed to Scarborough;
 - (ii) west and heading in an easterly direction, shall turn south onto Orange Hill Road and proceed either to Scarborough or north onto Mt. Marie Road;
 - (iii) west and heading in an easterly direction towards Wilson Road or Plymouth Road, shall proceed *via* Sangster's Hill Road or Dutch Fort Connector Road and proceed north, or if heading north along Dutch Fort Street, may turn west onto Dutch Fort Connector Road;
 - (iv) Northside Road, shall proceed in a southerly direction across the Claude Noel Highway; and
 - (v) Calder Hall Road, shall proceed either north or south across the Claude Noel Highway to Scarborough; and
- (b) exiting Scarborough to proceed to the—
 - (i) eastern side of Tobago, shall proceed west along Northside Road from Bacolet Connector Road *via* Crooks River (lower Scarborough), then south along Burnette Street, then north along Main Street, then south onto Bacolet Street and then east onto the Claude Noel Highway; and
 - (ii) western side of Tobago, shall proceed west along Carrington Street, continue west along Milford Road, then north along Orange Hill Road to either the Crusoe Bypass or the Claude Noel Highway.

6. A driver of an emergency vehicle at the Garden Side Car Park shall proceed south along Garden Side Street, then turn west onto Carrington Street, then proceed west along Milford Road, then turn north onto Orange Hill Road, then turn west onto the Claude Noel Highway, then turn north into Scarborough Regional Hospital.

7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
