THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to RYAN BARRINGTON also known as “RYIE” of No. 6 Mission Lane, Princes Town, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said RYAN BARRINGTON also known as “RYIE” of No. 6 Mission Lane, Princes Town, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre, located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or

such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said RYAN BARRINGTON also known as “RYIE” of No. 6 Mission Lane, Princes Town, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, RYAN BARRINGTON also known as “RYIE” has been identified through police investigations and confidential intelligence as a person involved in violent and organised criminal activity within the Princes Town area. Intelligence indicates that he has sought to assert control over narcotics distribution in the Cacique Street/Market Street area of Princes Town through intimidation, threats of violence and the use or threatened use of firearms. The detainee has also been associated with known offenders within the Princes Town district and is alleged to exercise influence over individuals willing to carry out criminal acts on his instructions. Intelligence suggests that these associations contribute to fear within the community and enhance his ability to facilitate organised criminal activity and violence.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
