AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Ordinance, Ch. 25. No. 9

[Assented to 4th September, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Fisheries (Amend- ^{Short title}
ment) Act, 1975.

2. The Fisheries Ordinance is amended—

- (a) in section 2 by substituting the words “to the Territorial Sea of Trinidad and Tobago as defined by the Territorial Sea Act, 1969;” for the words “all waters of the Colony within one marine league of the coast.” occurring in lines two and three;

- (b) in section 3—
- (i) by repealing paragraph (d) and replacing it as follows—
- “(d) prohibiting the killing, harpooning, taking, removing, catching or any other means of taking possession of fish or any variety thereof either absolutely or at such times and within such areas as may be prescribed;”;
- (ii) by adding immediately after paragraph (d) the following paragraph—
- “(e) prohibiting the sale, offering or exposing for sale or the purchase of fish or any variety thereof either absolutely or at such times and within such areas as may be prescribed.”;
- (c) by substituting the words “3A” for the words “34A” occurring in the Fisheries Ordinance as amended by section 2 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1966;
- (d) by repealing subsection (1) of section 4 and replacing it as follows—
- “4. (1) A person who contravenes any regulation made under this Ordinance is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars or to imprisonment for six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.”;

- (e) by substituting the words "one thousand dollars" for the words "five hundred dollars" occurring in line three of subsection (2) of section 5A;
- (f) by inserting the word "he" between the words "Ordinance, may" occurring in line four of subsection (2) of section 6.
