AN ORDINANCE to amend the Jury Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Jury (Amendment) Short title.
Ordinance, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Jury Ch. 4. No. 2.
Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 4

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by substituting the words “ four hundred and eighty ” for the words “ three hundred ” in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (f) ;
- (b) by substituting the words “ three hundred ” for the words “ two hundred and forty ” in sub-paragraph (ii) of the said paragraph ;
- (c) by substituting the words “ one thousand four hundred and forty ” for the words “ seven hundred and twenty ” in sub-paragraph (iii) of the said paragraph.

Application
of Ordinance.

3. The amendments to the Principal Ordinance enacted by section 2 of this Ordinance shall have effect in relation to, and for the purposes of, the preparation in the year 1952 and in every alternate year thereafter, of the lists of the names of persons qualified to serve as jurors, the revision of the said lists and the compilation of the Jurors Books therefrom.
