1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Administration of Short title
Estates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as
one with the Administration of Estates Ordinance, hereinafter Ch. 8. No. 1.
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

and 28 of the
Principal
Ordinance.

2. Sections 27 and 28 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by substituting for the words "Governor in Council" wherever those words appear in the said sections, the words "Governor or any person duly authorised by him".
