TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 41 of 1966**

AN ACT to amend the Judgments Extension Ordinance,  
Ch. 5. No. 9

[Assented to 30th December, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by  
the authority of the same as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the Judgments Extension <sup>Short title</sup>  
(Amendment) Act, 1966.

2. The Judgments Extension Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by substituting the words "Trinidad and Tobago" for the words "The Colony" wherever the latter words occur therein;
- (b) in section 2, by substituting for the definition of "Supreme Court" the following—
  - " "Supreme Court" means the Supreme Court of Judicature of Trinidad and Tobago and includes a Judge of the High Court of Justice;"
- (c) in subsection (2) of section 8, by substituting for the words "section 46 of the Judicature Ordinance" the words "section 76 of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962;"
- (d) by substituting for subsection (1) of section 9 thereof the following subsections—

"(1) Where the Governor-General is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of any Commonwealth country outside the United Kingdom for the enforcement within that Commonwealth country of judgments obtained in the Supreme Court, the Governor-General may by Order direct—

- (a) that this Ordinance shall extend to that Commonwealth country; and
- (b) that such courts of that Commonwealth country as are specified in the Order shall be deemed superior courts of that country for the purposes of this Act.

(1A) On an Order being made under subsection (1), the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply in the same manner to the Commonwealth country and to judgments obtained in a superior court of that country specified in the Order as they apply to the United Kingdom and to judgments obtained in a superior court in the United Kingdom.";

(e) by inserting between the words "include" and "any" occurring in the third line of subsection (2) of section 9 the following words :

"any independent country within the Commonwealth or any province or state thereof and".
