AN ACT to amend the Judges' Salaries and Pensions
Act, 1965.

[Assented to 16th December, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by **Enactment**
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges' Salaries and **Short title**
Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1971.

Section 4 of
Act No. 4 of
1965 repealed
and replaced

2. Section 4 of the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1965, is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“ 4. There shall be paid—

- (a) to the Chief Justice of Trinidad and Tobago, a salary of thirty-eight thousand, four hundred dollars a year;
- (b) to every Judge of the Court of Appeal, a salary of thirty-three thousand, six hundred dollars a year;
- (c) to every Judge of the High Court, a salary of thirty thousand dollars a year.”.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1971.
