AN ACT to amend the Judges Salaries and Pensions
Act, 1965.

[Assented to 2nd October, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges Salaries and ^{Short title}
Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1975.

Section 4 of
Act No. 4 of
1965 repealed
and replaced

2. Section 4 of the Judges Salaries and Pensions Act, 1965, is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“4. There shall be paid—

- (a) to the Chief Justice of Trinidad and Tobago, a salary of forty-nine thousand, nine hundred and twenty dollars a year;
- (b) to every Judge of the Court of Appeal, a salary of forty-three thousand, six hundred and eighty dollars a year;
- (c) to every Judge of the High Court a salary of thirty-nine thousand dollars a year.”.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1974.
