## ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, 1948

*Substances to which the Ordinance applies*

UNDER and by virtue of the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance, 1948 the Governor in Council hereby declares the following substances to be antibiotics to which the said Ordinance shall apply:—

- (a) Aureomycin, all compounds of Aureomycin and all medicinal preparations containing Aureomycin,
- (b) Chloromycetin, all compounds of Chloromycetin and all medicinal preparations containing Chloromycetin, and
- (c) Cytamen (Vitamin B 12 Concentrate) produced by deep fermentation methods from the mould *Streptomyces*.

Made by the Governor in Executive Council this 4th day of July, 1950.

## WAGES COUNCILS

*Sugar Industry Wages Council*

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ORDINANCE, 1949, No. 20 OF 1949

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by Section 3 of the Wages Councils Ordinance, 1949, No. 20 of 1949, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wages Council (Sugar Industry) Order, 1950.
2. There shall be established in respect of the workers to whom this Order applies as set out in the Schedule hereto, and their employers, a wages council to be known as the Sugar Industry Wages Council.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1950.

## SCHEDULE

*Workers to whom the Order applies*

1. Workers in the Colony employed by any person or undertaking engaged in the business of the cultivation of sugar canes and/or the manufacture and/or the refining of sugar, in respect of their employment for the purposes of such business and any operation incidental thereto.
