THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8.

SUBSTANCES TO WHICH THE ORDINANCE APPLIES

UNDER and by virtue of the provisions of section 2 of the Antibiotics Ordinance, Ch. 12. No. 8, the Governor in Council hereby declares the following additional substances to be antibiotics to which the said Ordinance shall apply :—

“Tetracycline, all compounds of Tetracycline and all medicinal preparations containing Tetracycline.”

ROADS REGULATIONS, 1932

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN EXECUTIVE COUNCIL UNDER THE ROADS REGULATIONS, 1932, FOR THE CONVERSION OF SANGRE CHIQUITO CIRCULAR ROAD ALSO KNOWN AS THE EASTERN MAIN ROAD IN THE WARD OF MANZANILLA, COUNTY OF ST. ANDREW, INTO A LOCAL ROAD

UNDER and by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Roads Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 1, and of the above Regulations, I do hereby order that the following main road in the Ward of Manzanilla, County of St. Andrew be converted into a local road:

Sangre Chiquito Circular Road also known as the Eastern Main Road, commencing from the 31.74 mile mark Eastern Main Road and running in a more or less south-easterly direction for a distance of 462 feet (through lands of General F. A. C. Pacheco and of the Canadian Mission School) and rejoining the Eastern Main Road at the 31.77 mile mark.
