THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8

SUBSTANCES TO WHICH THE ORDINANCE APPLIES

UNDER and by virtue of the provisions of section 2 of the Antibiotics Ordinance, Ch. 12. No. 8, the Governor in Council hereby declares the following additional substances to be antibiotics to which the said Ordinance shall apply :

"*Erythromycin*, all compounds of Erythromycin and all medicinal preparations containing Erythromycin".

"*Neomycin*, all compounds of Neomycin and all medicinal preparations containing Neomycin."
