ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE
ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE

THE ANTIBIOTICS (POLYMYXINS) ORDER, 1955

1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Polymyxins) Order, 1955.
2. The following anti-microbial organic substances produced by living organisms are hereby declared to be antibiotics to which the Antibiotics Ordinance shall apply:—

The Polymyxins, all compounds of the Polymyxins and all medicinal preparations containing the Polymyxins, other than *Aerosporin Otic Solution and Polyfax Ointment.*
