THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION (PENSIONS) ORDINANCE,

MOTION ADOPTED AT A MEETING OF THE ARIMA BOROUGH
COUNCIL ON THE 27TH JUNE, 1963

THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 20A OF THE
ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8

THE ANTIBIOTICS (KANAMYCIN) ORDER, 1964

1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Kanamycin) Order, 1964.
2. The Schedule to the Antibiotics Ordinance as contained in the Antibiotics (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following antimicrobial organic substances produced by living organisms:
Kanamycin, all compounds of Kanamycin, and all medical preparations containing Kanamycin.
