2. The Schedule to the Antibiotics Ordinance as contained in the Antibiotics (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following antimicrobial organic substances produced by living organisms:—

“Cephaloridine also called Ceporin
Methacycline also called Randomycin.”
