THE ANTIBIOTIC ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8

APPROVED PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of the Antibiotic Ordinance, Ch. 12. No. 8, I, KAMALUDDIN MOHAMMED, Minister of Health, do hereby, on recommendation of the Antibiotics Control Committee, add the following antibiotic preparation to the list of Antibiotics that may be imported into Trinidad and Tobago.
