THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, CH. 12. No. 8

APPROVED PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of the Antibiotics Ordinance, Ch. 12 No. 8, I, KAMALUDDIN MOHAMMED, Minister of Health, do hereby, on the recommendation of the Antibiotics Control Committee, add the following antibiotic preparations to the list of Antibiotics that may be imported into Trinidad and Tobago.
