

3. (1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be, or remain parked on the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway or the Princess Margaret Highway.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of subparagraph (1) of this paragraph shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars or imprisonment for three months.
