NOTICE

ISSUED UNDER SECTION 7(1) OF THE PETROLEUM ACT, 1969

In accordance with the provisions of section 7(1) of the Petroleum Act, 1969, Notice is hereby given that Trinidad-Tesoro Petroleum Company Limited has made written application to the Minister of Petroleum and Mines for a Pipe-Line Licence to lay a buried 4 inch (natural gas) pipeline at Point Fortin in the Ward of La Brea and subject to consideration of any objections which may be received by him pursuant to this Notice, the Minister of Petroleum and Mines proposes to issue to Trinidad-Tesoro Petroleum Co. Limited a Pipe-Line Licence to construct, install, maintain and operate the pipe-line described in the Schedule hereunder along the route detailed and shown on the map attached.

Any person who objects to the laying of such a pipe-line on the grounds specified in section 8 of the Petroleum Act, is hereby invited to give notice of his objections and of the grounds on which he relies in support thereof to the Minister of Petroleum and Mines within thirty days of the publication of this Notice.
