AN ACT to amend the National Emblems of Trinidad and  
Tobago (Regulation) Act, 1967.

*[Assented to 24th April, 1980]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the **National Emblems of** Short title  
Trinidad and Tobago (Regulation) (Amendment) Act,  
1980.

Section 1 of  
Act No. 14 of 1967  
amended

2. Section 1 of the National Emblems of Trinidad and Tobago (Regulation) Act, 1967, (hereinafter called "the Act"), is amended in subsection (2) by substituting for the words "Governor-General" occurring in line two, the word "President".

Validation

3. All acts or things done by the Committee established by section 4 of the Act in purported exercise of any of its functions, duties or powers under the Act shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done.
