**Act No. 8 of 1963**

AN ACT to amend the Nurses and Midwives  
Registration Ordinance, 1960.

[Assented to 26th March, 1963]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment  
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House  
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Short title  
Registration (Amendment) Act, 1963.

Interpretation

**2.** In this Act, "the Ordinance" means the Nurses and Midwives Registration Ordinance.

**3.** Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by the deletion of the word "twenty" occurring in the first line thereof and the substitution therefor of the word "twenty-two";
- (b) by the deletion of the word "four" occurring in the first line of paragraph (b) and the substitution therefor of the word "five";
- (c) by the insertion in paragraph (b) immediately after the words "trained in teaching midwifery," of the words "one a person having experience in the teaching or administration of mental nursing";
- (d) by the addition immediately after paragraph (e) of the following paragraph:—
  - "(f) one person elected from among their own number by the persons who are registered as mental nurses under this Ordinance at the date of the election."

**4.** Section 21 of the Ordinance is amended by the insertion immediately after subsection (2) thereof of the following:

"(3) Any person who establishes to the satisfaction of the Council that she is registered or is entitled to be placed on the register of the Central Midwives Board of the United Kingdom or on the register of any other Midwives' Board or body recognized by the Council, and that she is a fit and proper person to be entered on the Register as a

midwife shall, on making application to the Council and upon compliance with the requirements of the Ordinance, be entitled to be registered.”
