AN ORDINANCE to amend the Liquor Licenses
Ordinance, No. 177.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licenses Short title.
