AN ORDINANCE to amend the Liquor Licences  
Ordinance, 1955.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.  
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licences Short Title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be read as one with No. 27 of 1955.  
the Liquor Licences Ordinance, 1955, hereinafter referred to  
as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 43 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the expression "sections 38, 40, 41, 42 and 45" for the expression "sections 38, 40, 41 and 42" appearing therein.

Section 45 of  
Principal  
Ordinance  
repealed and  
replaced.

3. Section 45 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

"Special  
licences.

45. (1) The Comptroller may, on the direction of the Governor in Council and on payment to him of such duty, if any, as the Governor in Council may in each case determine, issue a special licence to—

- (a) the General Manager of the Railway, or any person nominated by him, authorising the sale of any intoxicating liquor at any station or on any train of the Government Railway;
- (b) the General Manager of the Port Services Department, or any person authorised by him, authorising the sale of any intoxicating liquor to passengers on board any Government steamer;
- (c) the Director of Civil Aviation, or any person nominated by him, authorising the sale of any intoxicating liquor at any airport in Trinidad or Tobago;
- (d) any owner or officer of a passenger steamship regularly plying between ports or places in Trinidad or Tobago, authorising the sale of any intoxicating liquor to passengers on board any such ship.

(2) A licence under this section shall authorise the sale of intoxicating liquor in such quantity and such manner and during such hours and on such days as the Governor in Council may in each case determine."

Passed in Council this twenty-fourth day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty.
