AN ACT to amend the Liquor Licences Ordinance, 1955,
No. 27 of 1955.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment.}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licences (Amend- ^{Short title.}
ment) Act, 1971.

2. Section 7 of the Liquor Licences Ordinance, 1955 is amended by substituting for the words "as the case may be" occurring at the end thereof, the words "respectively, save that the Chief Magistrate may, if he thinks fit, designate a public officer either generally or for any special occasion, to perform the duties of the Secretary of a licensing committee instead of the Clerk of the Peace for the magisterial district conterminous with the licensing district of such a committee or the Clerk of the Peace for the licensing area".
