THE HIGHWAYS ACT, CHAP. 48:01

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT

THE CLASSIFICATION OF HIGHWAYS (EXTENSION OF
SPECIAL ROAD) ORDER, 1989

WHEREAS by the Classification of Highways (Amendment) Order, 1977, the Priority Bus Route was classified a special road and its limits defined:

And whereas it is necessary to extend that road in an easterly direction:

Now, therefore, the Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Act, orders as follows—

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Classification of Highways (Extension of Special Road) Order, 1989.

Special road extended 2. The Priority Bus Route is extended from Five Rivers Junction, Arouca, in an easterly direction, along the Trinidad Government Railway reserve, to Subero Street, Arima.
