#### AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 3.

[13th March, 1952.]

Commence-

**E** NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with Enactment the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and short title Road Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, <sup>Ch. 16. No. 3</sup> hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 3 (1) of Principal Ordinance amended

2. Subsection (1) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the expression "the Commissioner of Police or such other Gazetted Police Officer of the Police Force as may be nominated in writing for the purpose by the Commissioner of Police, the Licensing Authority," for the expression "the Commissioner of Police".
