ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Short title
Road Traffic (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be
read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Ch. 16. No. 3

2. Subsection (2) of section 68 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsection :—

“(2) Any person who by any act or omission contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of any regulations made under this Ordinance shall, unless otherwise specifically provided, be liable to a fine of forty-eight dollars or to imprisonment for twenty-one days.”
