AN ORDINANCE to amend the Food and Drugs
Ordinance, Cap. 107.

[21st March, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Food and Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931.

of s. 9 of

2. Paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Food and Drugs Ordinance, Cap. 107, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "brandy":

(other than brandy imported in bottle and sold intact in the bottles in which it is imported)
