AN ACT to amend the Food and Drugs Ordinance, 1960.

[Assented to 20th January, 1969]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Food and Drugs ^{Short title}
(Amendment) Act, 1968.

2. Subsection (1) of section 26 of the Food and Drugs Ordinance is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“(1) The Minister may establish in the interest and for the protection of public health—

(a) a Drug Advisory Committee to assist and advise him with respect to—

(i) drug standards, schedules of drugs, conditions of sale of drugs, and

(ii) cosmetic standards, labelling of cosmetics,

and any other matters connected therewith;

(b) a Food Advisory Committee to assist and advise him with respect to food standards, labelling and other matters connected with the manufacture and distribution of food.”.
