AN ACT to amend the Food and Drugs Act, Chap. 30:01

[Assented to 18th May, 1987]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Food and Drugs Short title
(Amendment) Act, 1987.

2. The Food and Drugs Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by repealing and replacing subsection (2) of section 25 as follows—

" (2) Regulations made under this section may prescribe in respect of any contravention thereof or failure to comply therewith, liability, on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of one thousand, five hundred dollars and imprisonment for three months and for a subsequent offence to a fine of three thousand dollars and imprisonment for six months."

Third Schedule

3. The Act is amended in the Third Schedule—

(a) by deleting the following drugs from Part I of the Schedule—

"Benzodiazepine derivatives—the following and their salts:

Diazepam

Nitrazepam

Oxazepam

Chlordiazepoxide and its salts

Glutethimide

Methaqualene and its salts

Methylphenidate and its salts";

(b) by deleting the following drug from Part II of the Schedule—

"Meprobamate".
