

Interpretation

2. In this Act the "Act" means the Food and Drugs Act.

Section 2 amended

3. Section 2 of the Act is amended by inserting at the end of the definition of the word "drug", the following definition:

" 'exporter' in relation to any article to be exported, includes any person who, whether as owner, consignor, agent or broker is in possession of the article or in any way entitled to the custody or control of it;".

Section 8A inserted

4. The Act is amended by inserting after section 8 the following section:

"8A. The offences created by sections 8 and 9 shall apply to food processed or prepared for export to be processed or prepared for export."

Section 22 amended

5. Section 22 of the Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (1)—

(i) by inserting in the marginal note at the end of the word "importations" the words "and exportations";

(ii) by inserting after the words "Trinidad and Tobago" the words, "or documents relating to the exportation of food, drugs or cosmetics;";

(b) in subsection (2), by inserting after the word "importer" the words, "or exporter".

Section 25 amended

6. Section 25(1) of the Act is amended—

(a) in paragraph (d), by inserting after the word "importation" the words, "or exportation";

(b) by inserting the following paragraph at the end of paragraph (d):

"(dd) providing for the issue of licences for the importation
