ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS, SETTLEMENTS AND INFRASTRUCTURE
UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER, 1987

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control Order, 1987.

Citation

PART I—PORT-OF-SPAIN

2. Motorists may not park their vehicles on—

Parking
prohibited

- (a) the eastern side only of George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (b) the eastern side only of Charlotte Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (c) Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street.

3. Motorists proceeding in a northerly direction along Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South, shall turn left into Independence Square South.

Left turn
only

4. (1) Taxi drivers may park not more than thirty-one taxis facing North on the western side of George Street, from a point nine metres from Independence Square South extending southwards.

Taxi stand

- (2) Taxi drivers may park not more than fourteen taxis facing North on the western side of Charlotte Street, from a point nine metres from Independence Square South extending southwards.

5. Motorists shall proceed in a northerly direction only on Charlotte Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South.

One-way
traffic

6. Motorists proceeding in a southerly direction along Nelson Street may not turn right into South Quay.

No right
turn

7. Vehicular traffic may not turn at the end of the median on South Quay, between Duncan Street and Nelson Street, so as to face a direction opposite to that in which they were originally proceeding.

No "U" turn

PART II—SANGRE GRANDE

8. Motorists shall proceed in a westerly direction only on Savi Street, between Boodoosingh Circular and the Eastern Main Road.

One-way
traffic

9. (1) Taxi drivers may park not more than ten taxis facing West on the northern side of Savi Street from a point nine metres from the Eastern Main Road extending eastwards to a point nine metres from Boodoosingh Circular.

Taxi stands

(2) Taxi drivers may park not more than twelve taxis facing South on the eastern side of Ojoe Road from a point nine metres from the Eastern Main Road extending in a northerly direction.

PART III—CHAGUANAS

Parking
prohibited

10. Motorists may not park their vehicles on—

- (a) Yard Street, between St. Yves Street and Endeavour Road;
- (b) Endeavour Road, between Yard Street and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (c) Mark Street, between Eleanor Street and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (d) Trial Street, between the Chaguanas Main Road and Yard Street;
- (e) Caroni Savannah Road, between the Chaguanas Main Road and Frederick Street;
- (f) Caroni Savannah Road, between the Chaguanas Main Road and Endeavour Exchange;
- (g) the eastern and western sides of Railway Station Road;
- (h) the Chaguanas Main Road, from the Southern Main Road to Cumberbatch Street;
- (i) the Southern Main Road, from the Chaguanas Main Road to Desmond Street;
- (j) De Verteuil Street, between the Uriah Butler Highway and the Southern Main Road;
- (k) John Street, between De Verteuil Street and Gaston Street;
- (l) Andrew Street, between the Southern Main Road and Algernon Street; and
- (m) the northern side only of Yard Street, between Access Street and Endeavour Road.

Parking
restricted

11. Motorists may park their vehicles on—

- (a) the northern side only of Eleanor Street;
- (b) the eastern side only of the Southern Main Road, between Eleanor Street and the Chaguanas Main Road, except that taxi drivers shall park their taxis in the taxi stand;
- (c) the western side only of St. Yves Street, except that taxi drivers shall park their taxis in the taxi stand;
- (d) the eastern side only of Marie Street;
- (e) the western side only of Railway Road West, between the Warden's Office and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (f) the western side only of Railway Road East, between the Chaguanas Main Road and the Warden's Office; and
- (g) the western side only of the Old Southern Main Road, between the Southern Main Road and Grace Street.

12. Motorists shall proceed—

One-way
traffic

- (a) in a westerly direction only on the Chaguanas Main Road, between Endeavour Road and St. Yves Street;
- (b) in an easterly direction only on Eleanor Street;
- (c) in a northerly direction only on Trial Street;
- (d) in a southerly direction only on Endeavour Road, between Yard Street and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (e) in an easterly direction only on Yard Street, between the Chaguanas Main Road and Endeavour Road;
- (f) in a southerly direction only on Marie Street;
- (g) in a northerly direction only on St. Yves Street, between the Chaguanas Main Road and Rennie Street;
- (h) in a southerly direction only on Railway Road West, between the Warden's Office and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (i) in a southerly direction only on Railway Road East, between the Warden's Office and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (j) in a northerly direction only on De Verteuil Street, between John Street and the Chaguanas Main Road;
- (k) in an easterly direction only on John Street;
- (l) in a southerly direction only on Gaston Street, between Penco Street and the Southern Main Road;
- (m) in a northerly direction only on Henry Street, between Penco Street and the Southern Main Road; and
- (n) in a northerly direction only on Andrew Street, between Algernon Street and the Southern Main Road.

13. (1) Motorists leaving the junction of the Southern Main Road and the Chaguanas Main Road desirous of proceeding East, shall turn West into the Chaguanas Main Road, North into Trial Street, East into Yard Street, South into Endeavour Road and East into the Chaguanas Main Road.

Traffic at
junctions

(2) Motorists proceeding from the Endeavour Road Junction into the Chaguanas Main Road to Freeport, shall turn West into the Chaguanas Main Road, South into Mark Street, East into Eleanor Street and into the Southern Main Road.

14. (1) Motorists shall turn left on entering the Chaguanas Main Road from the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway.

Left turn

(2) Motorists proceeding South on De Verteuil Street shall turn left into John Street.

15. (1) Motorists proceeding West along the Chaguanas Main Road may not make a "U" turn at the western end of the median.

No "U" turn
at median

(2) Motorists proceeding East along the Chaguanas Main Road may not make a "U" turn at the eastern end of the median.

16. (1) Penco Street is deemed the major road at its intersections with Gaston Street, Henry Street and Smith Street.

Changes to
major and
minor roads

(2) John Street is deemed the major road at its intersections with Gaston Street, Henry Street and Smith Street.

PART IV—FREEPORT

- Taxi stand** 17. Taxi drivers may park not more than ten taxis facing West on the northern side of Mission Road from a point nine metres East of the Southern Main Road extending eastwards.

PART V—GASPARILLO

- Parking prohibited** 18. Motorists may not park their vehicles on Bonne Aventure Road, between the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway and Victoria Street.

PART VI—SAN FERNANDO

- One-way traffic** 19. Between 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. Mondays to Fridays motorists shall proceed—

- (a) in a southerly direction only on Jarvis Street, between Pointe-a-Pierre Road and Manjack Street; and
- (b) in a northerly direction only on Bay Road, from a point one hundred metres North of Elizabeth Street to the Southern Main Road.

- Parking prohibited** 20. Motorists may not park their vehicles on—
- (a) Cipero Street from a point fifty metres North of Park Street extending southwards;
 - (b) Cipero Street from a point fifty metres North of Scott Street extending southwards; and
 - (c) the southern side of Rushworth Street Extension.

- No right turn** 21. (1) Motorists proceeding East on Rushworth Street may not turn right into Cipero Street.
- (2) Motorists proceeding West on Rushworth Street may not turn right into Cipero Street.

PART VII—SIPARIA

- One-way traffic** 22. Motorists shall proceed in a northerly direction only on Edward Street, between Mary Street and the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road.

- Taxi stands** 23. Taxi drivers may park not more than ten taxis facing North on the western side of Edward Street, from a point nine metres with its junction with the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road extending southwards.

PART VIII—FYZABAD

- One-way traffic** 24. Motorists shall proceed in a southerly direction only on Lumtack Hill, from a point one hundred and fifty metres North of Siparia Road.

- Taxi stand** 25. Taxi drivers may park eight taxis only on the western side of Lumtack Hill, from a point nine metres from the junction with Siparia Road extending northwards.

PART IX—POINT FORTIN

26. Motorists may not park their vehicles on the western side of Adventure Road, between Richardson Street and Frisco Roundabout. Parking prohibited

27. Taxi drivers may park not more than eight maxi-taxis facing South on the eastern side of Adventure Road, from a point thirteen metres North of Sylvester Street extending northward to a point nine metres South of Lyle Street. Maxi-taxi stand

PART X—TOBAGO

28. Motorists may not park on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Post Office Street, between 7.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and between 3.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays;
- (b) the western side of Gardenside Street, between Darrell Spring Road and Carrington Street, between 7.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and between 3.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays;
- (c) the western side of Wilson Road;
- (d) the eastern side of Gardenside Street; and
- (e) the western side of Picton Street.

29. Motorists shall proceed—

One-way traffic

- (a) in a westerly direction only on Carrington Street, between Gardenside Street and Wilson Road;
- (b) in a westerly direction only on Post Office Street, between Gardenside Street and Wilson Road;
- (c) in a southerly direction only on Dutch Fort Road, between Wilson Road and Milford Road;
- (d) in a southerly direction only on Gardenside Street, between Darrell Spring Road and Carrington Street;
- (e) in a northerly direction only on Wilson Road, between Darrell Spring Road and Milford Road;
- (f) in a northerly direction only on Picton Street, between Main Street and Piggott Street;
- (g) in an easterly direction only on Darrell Spring Road, between Wilson Road and Gardenside Street;
- (h) in an easterly direction only on Hamilton Street;
- (i) in an easterly direction only on Piggott Street, between Burnett Street and Bacolet Street.

30. Motorists proceeding—

Left turn

- (a) West on Carrington Street shall turn left into Castries Street;
- (b) South on Wilson Road from the Claude Noel Highway, shall turn left into Darrell Spring Road;
- (c) East on Milford Road, shall turn left into Wilson Road.

31. Motorists proceeding West on Post Office Street, shall turn right into Wilson Road. Right turn

No right
turn

32. Motorists proceeding—

- (a) North on Mount Marie Road may not turn right into the Claude Noel Highway;
- (b) North along Castries Street may not turn right into Carrington Street;
- (c) out of the Kirpalani car park may not turn right into Gardenside Street.

No left
turn

33. Motorists proceeding out of the NIPDEC car park may not turn left into Gardenside Street.

No entry

34. Motorists proceeding West on Carrington Street may not enter Gardenside Street.

Goods
vehicles

35. On Mondays to Fridays not more than fourteen goods vehicles may park at any one time adjacent to Wilson Road at the Scarborough Market Square.

Taxi stands

36. Taxi drivers may park—

- (a) not more than eight taxis facing East at the Scarborough Market Square, between the lines demarcated on the surface of the Square for the parking of motor vehicles;
- (b) not more than nine taxis plying the western routes, facing West on the South side of Milford Road, immediately West of the corner of Wilson Road;
- (c) not more than nine taxis facing West on the southern side of Carrington Street, from a point three metres West of the Customs Street exit extending in a westerly direction to a point nine metres East of Gardenside Street;
- (d) not more than six taxis facing East on the southern side of Piggott Street, between Jerningham Street and Burnett Street;
- (e) not more than five taxis plying the north-western routes facing North on the western side of Wilson Road, from a point nine metres from its intersection with Milford Road extending northwards;
- (f) not more than eight taxis plying the windward routes facing East on the north-western corner of the Scarborough Car Park, between the lines demarcated for the parking of motor vehicles.

PART XI—GENERAL

Offence

37. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months.

Removal
and
impounding

38. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
