THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (PRINCES TOWN) REGULATIONS, 2000

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Princes Town) Regulations, 2000.
- 2. These Regulations have effect from 28th April to 28th July, Commencement and cessation
- 3. Motorists shall proceed in a northerly direction only on Buen One-way Intento Road between Waterlane and Cacique Streets.
- 4. Motorists proceeding west on the Naparima-Mayaro Road shall No right turn not turn right into Railway Road.
- 5. Motorists proceeding east along Tramline Road shall turn left $Left\ turn\ only\ into\ Railway\ Road.$
- 6. Parking is prohibited on Charlotte Street between the hours of Parking 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
 - 7. Motorists may proceed in either direction on Charlotte Street. Two-way traffic
- 8. Taxi drivers plying the Williamsville Route may park a Taxi stands maximum of twelve taxis on the western side of Railway Road facing north.
- 9. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these offence and regulations is liable on summary conviction to a fine of seven hundred penalty and fifty dollars (\$750.00) and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

Chap. 48:50

10. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap. 48:50.
