AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Launches
Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 6.

[30th March, 1944.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Launches
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1944, and shall be read as one
with the Motor Launches Ordinance, (hereinafter referred
to as the Principal Ordinance).

Sections 5 and
6 of the
Principal

2. Sections 5 and 6 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by inserting the words "of Port-of-Spain" immediately after the words "Harbour Master" when they occur in the said sections.

New para-
graph added to
section 15 of
the Principal
Ordinance.

3. Subsection (1) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (1) by relettering paragraphs (j) and (k) as paragraphs (k) and (l) respectively; and
- (2) by inserting the following paragraph as paragraph (j) immediately after paragraph (i) thereof:—

"(j) prescribing the charges to be paid for the hiring or use of motor launches"

Passed in Council this twenty-fourth day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.
